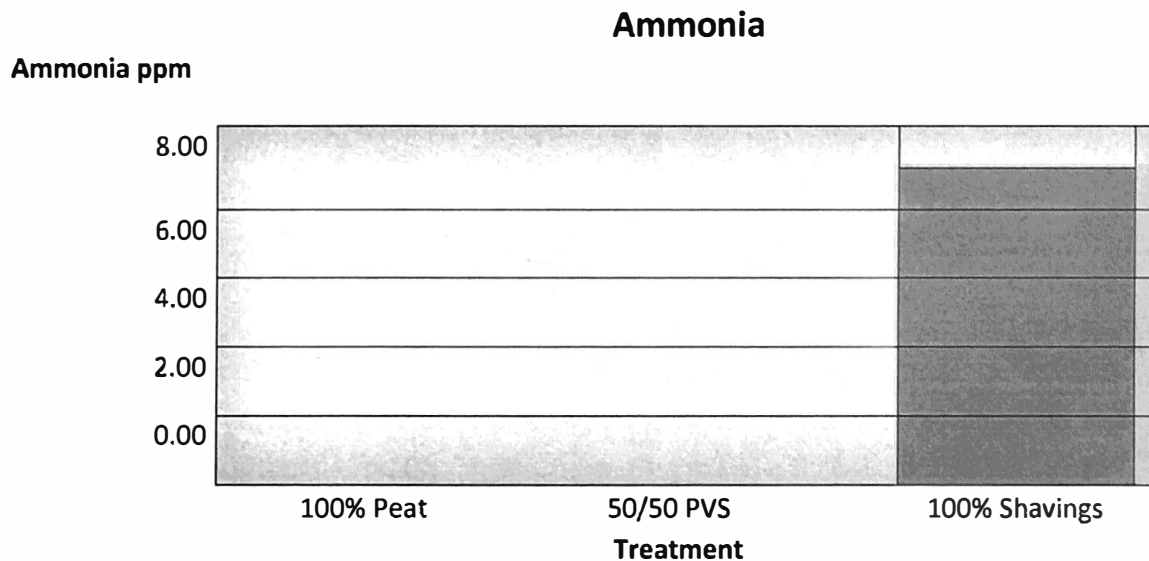


RECOMMENDATIONS FOR USING PEAT MOSS AS ANIMAL BEDDING FOR HORSES

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Warning: Do not use during birth of foals

For the maximum benefit for the horse and the environment.

- 1. Start with a clean stall**
- 2. Spread to a recommended depth of 2 – 3 inches**
- 3. Spray with a light mist of water to set bedding (and control dust)**
- 4. Pick stalls as usual and replenish as needed**

5. Strip stalls every 6+ weeks (on average) or as needed

MIX (BEDDING & WOOD SHAVINGS)

Increase moisture absorption, ammonia binding, horse comfort, extend bedding life.

1. It has been proven effective when mixed with traditional bedding at the 50% level
2. A total depth at 4 – 5 inches is ideal

		COVERAGE CHART (2.2 Compressed) for 100 sq. ft. (10' x 10') and 3 inches deep*		
		100% bedding	50% bedding 50% wood shavings	25% bedding 75% wood shavings
10'	10'	6 bales	3 bales	2 bales

*If your stalls are smaller or larger than those listed, please use the following formula to arrive at the approximate depth of 3": Length (ft.) X Width (ft.) X .25 = Total Cubic Feet 3.0 for Loose Fill or 4.4 for Compressed.

DISPOSAL

After initial stall application, it offers a secondary benefit to your garden, pastures and cropland. This is a Full Cycle of Use product meaning it has multiple uses along its life cycle and is then returned to the Earth – where it originated – never becoming waste or landfill material.
